CSI is Tribally owned by the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians (MBCI) and was certified as an SBA Tribally Owned 8(a) small business in March 2022. CSI will soon apply for HUBZone status.

The CHG companies share management and have consolidated corporate functions such as HR, Legal, and Accounting. Sister company past performance represents actual personnel, knowledge and experience with military facilities that can be applied to the contract.
